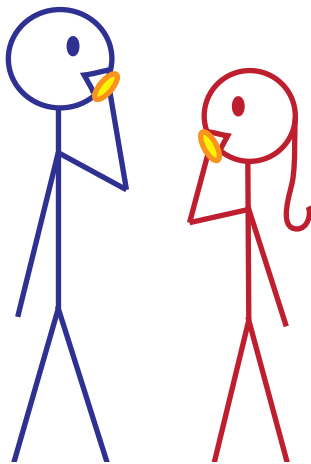
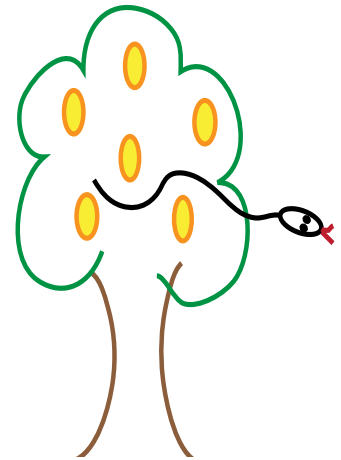
Memory Verse: Genesis 3:21

The Serpent

Read aloud: Genesis 3:1-5

Discuss The Serpent: Remind the students what God had told Adam about the trees in the Garden. The serpent talked to Eve and lied to her about the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Eve disobeyed God and ate the forbidden fruit.

Draw and have students draw: The serpent talking to Eve from a tree.



Adam and Eve Sinned

Read aloud: Genesis 3:6

Discuss Adam and Eve Sinned: Eve gave Adam the forbidden fruit, and he too disobeyed God and ate. When Adam and Eve disobeyed God by eating the fruit, they sinned.

Draw and have students draw: Adam and Eve eating the forbidden fruit.

Lesson Review:

1. What lie did the serpent tell Eve? *She could eat the forbidden fruit without punishment.*
2. What did Adam and Eve do with the forbidden fruit? *They ate the forbidden fruit and sinned against God.*
3. When God questioned Adam and Eve about eating the fruit, how did they respond? *Adam blamed Eve, and Eve blamed the serpent.*
4. When Adam and Eve left the garden, what did God give them? *Clothes made from animal skins.*
5. What did you learn about sin? *Sin is disobeying God.*

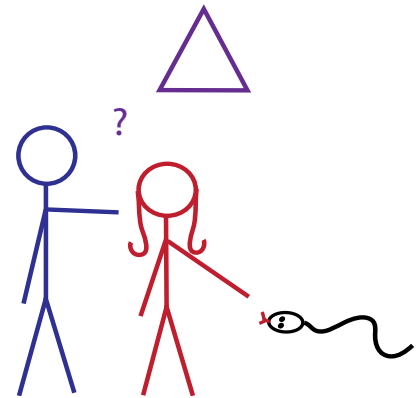
Memory Verse: Genesis 3:21

God Talked to Adam and Eve

Read aloud: [Genesis 3:8-13](#)

Discuss God Talked to Adam and Eve: When God came to the garden, Adam and Eve hid from Him. God knew that Adam and Eve had eaten the forbidden fruit, but He still questioned them. Adam blamed Eve, and Eve blamed the serpent.

Draw and have students draw: God questioning Adam, Adam blaming Eve, and Eve blaming the serpent.

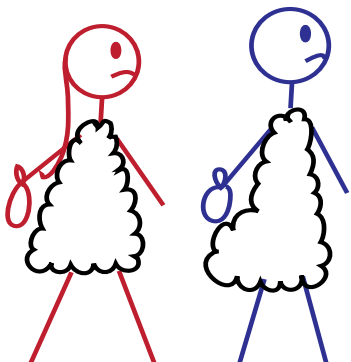


Adam and Eve Left the Garden

Read aloud: [Genesis 3:21-24](#)

Discuss Adam and Eve Left the Garden: God told Adam and Eve they would have to leave the Garden of Eden because they had sinned by disobeying Him. Before Adam and Eve left the garden, God gave them clothes made out of animal skins.

Draw and have students draw: Adam and Eve leaving the garden.




