

Teaching Catechism Books

Schedule

Each Question & Answer should take about 5-10 minutes to complete. Depending on the variety of ages in your class, you can go as quickly or as slowly as needed for each question/answer.

Before Class

Lesson Preparation: Nothing can replace the time a teacher spends in prayer with our Master Teacher, the Lord God Almighty. We also recommend you read the Scriptures and lesson notes before class.



Supplies: Supplies needed for teaching:

- Bible
- Dry erase board or chalk board
- Dry erase markers or chalk
- Colored pencils
- Lesson pages for each student
- Bible Dictionary



Teaching

Question: As the teacher, you verbally ask the question. If time permits, you can have students begin reading some of the questions before class and thinking about their answers. Teachers can then listen and discuss the various answers before proceeding.

Scripture: Once the question is asked, then the Scripture can be read to find the answer to the question.

Answer: Each question has a specific answer. The teacher will restate the question, give the correct answer, repeat the question, and allow the students to give the correct answer before writing it into their books. This is a good time to discuss the answer.

Stick Figure: This is the fun part! The teacher will stick figure the answer on the board, and students will stick figure the answer in their books. Encourage your students to be creative in their drawing because this will help them remember the answer better.
