Memory Verse: Genesis 11:9

God Made a Promise

Read aloud: Genesis 9:9, 11-13

Discuss God Made a Promise: After the Flood was over and Noah, his family, and the animals left the ark, God promised them that He would never again flood the whole earth. A sign of God's promise was the rainbow.

Draw and have students draw: A rainbow

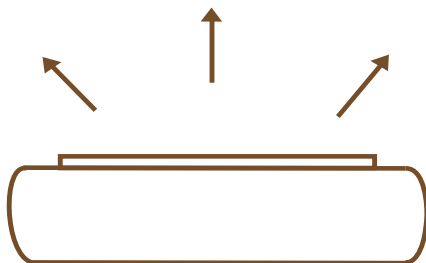


God Commanded the People to Scatter

Read aloud: Genesis 9:1

Discuss God Commanded the People to Scatter: When the Flood was over, God commanded the people to scatter and fill the earth.

Draw and have students draw: Arrows going out from the ark.



Lesson Review:

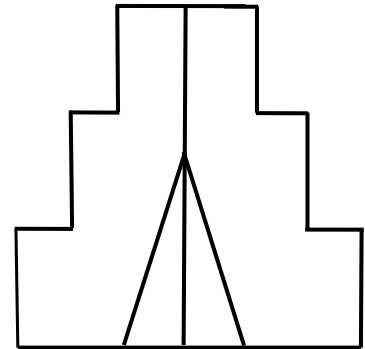
- 1. What promise did God make to man and the animals after the Flood?** God promised never again to flood the whole earth.
- 2. What was the sign of God's promise?** The sign of God's promise was the rainbow.
- 3. What did God command the people to do after the Flood?** God commanded the people to scatter and fill the earth.
- 4. What did the people do after the Flood?** The people gathered and built a city and a tower.
- 5. What did God do when the people built the Tower of Babel?** The people gathered and built a city and a tower at Babel.
- 6. What did you learn about the Tower of Babel?** God confused the language of the people and scattered them all over the earth because of their disobedience.

Read aloud: [Genesis 11:7](#)

Discuss The Tower: Instead of obeying God and scattering throughout the earth, the people disobeyed God and gathered to build a city named Babel. In Babel they built a tall tower.

God Confused the Language

Read aloud: [Genesis 11:8-9](#)

Discuss God Confused the Language: When the people disobeyed God, He confused their languages and scattered them throughout the earth.

Draw and have students draw: [Two people talking in different languages](#).





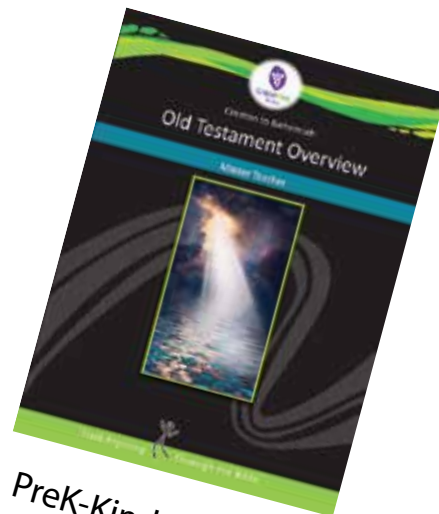
